**A 5-Step Guide to  
Protect Your Brand Voice**

You don't need another complicated AI workflow. You need a simple way to use AI in your marketing without losing your voice, your loyal people or your sanity.

This worksheet helps you protect what's human in your brand while still using AI to move faster and have more fun. Use it yourself, or run through it with your team in a 30–45 minute working session.

## **How to use** this worksheet

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- Print it or open it in Google Docs.
- Work through the questions in order – foundations first, then 80/20, then AI rules.
- Set a timer (30–45 minutes) and aim for imperfect, honest answers, not “perfect brand statements”.
- Once it's complete, turn your answers into:
  - A simple AI “rules of engagement” doc for your team
  - A checklist you use before you publish AI-assisted content
- Revisit every 3 months as your business and AI evolves.
- Then include the steps we already built:
  - Step 1** – Clarify your foundations
  - Step 2** – Decide your 80/20 content mix
  - Step 3** – Set your “AI junior copywriter” rules
  - Step 4** – Proof and trust check
  - Step 5** – Personalisation and experiment list

**STEP 1:**

**Clarify your foundations  
(do this before AI)**

1. What is your brand's core promise in one sentence?

2. List three words that describe your brand voice (e.g. bold, warm, playful).

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3. Who are your top two audience segments (e.g. "Millennial mums starting side businesses")?

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4. What do they care about most right now (top three problems or desires)?

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5. Where can you find their real talking points? (Reviews, DMs, emails, sales calls, surveys.)

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**STEP 2:** **Decide your 80/20 content mix**

1. List 3–5 “non-negotiable” content pieces that must be written by you (or a human who knows your brand deeply):

- *Example: About page, core sales page, signature service page, welcome email, pitch deck.*

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2. These pieces are your 80 per cent “human-led” content.

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3. List 3–5 content areas where AI can help you experiment. This is your 20 per cent “AI playground” content:

- *Example: Subject line options, hook ideas, content repurposing, social post variations.*

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**STEP 3:**

**Set your AI Junior Copywriter rules**

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2. Where will I show that proof?

- *Example: Landing page, email, socials, webinar.*

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3. Does this piece clearly show how I'm different from "AI-blended" competitors? If not, what strong opinion or story can I add?

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**STEP 5:**

**Personalisation  
and experiment list**

1. One simple way I can personalise my marketing using AI this month is:

- *Example: Segment my email list by topic and ask AI to help draft tailored follow-ups.*

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2. One experiment I will run in public (with my audience) in the next 30 days:
